Any future development costs must be borne by the trust and not the Parish Council. The Betty Cameron Playing Field committee were cited as a good example having explored grants and alternative funding before coming to the Parish Council for a donation. The next Berry Close meeting on the 19 February 2018 will be attended by Cllr Gliwitzki in the capacity of Parish Council Trustee and Cllr Richard Bee as a member. Prior to the Trust being formed the Parish Council received clear advice on what the field can be used for so any proposals need to heed the advice from the solicitors employed. Berry Close Trust requested the view of the Parish Council on a non-denominational burial ground. The Parish Council voted and a majority were in favour.</p>
